- All DOUBLES (non-Unified) will bowl in the **2nd shift**, along with some SINGLES. All of these divisions will be numbered in the 200's.
- We will only be using Lanes 1-12 in the **3rd shift**. This shift will consist of some UNIFIED DOUBLES and some SINGLES. All of these divisions will be numbered in the 300's.

DIRECTIONS TO ALL STAR LANES:

From Kingston Ferry : Stay straight onto Bond Rd. Bond road will lead into Poulsbo. At the last light on Bond road turn right. Go 1 block and turn left onto Viking Way. Viking Way will lead into Silverdale. All Star Lanes will be on the left.

From Bremerton Ferry : Stay straight and take a right onto Warren Ave. Go 5 miles and the street will turn into a highway. Once on the highway, go 2 miles and take the Silverdale Way exit. Take a left from the off ramp and All Star Lanes will be on the left.

TOURNAMENT NOTES

- **FOOD:** No Lunches or Water will be provided at this tournament. Please inform your athletes and parents the snack bar will be open.
- **NAME TAGS:** Please turn in NAME TAGS of those athletes who are not bowling (Scratches) to ANGIE RAMOS A.S.A.P. before the shift begins. We need to remove their names from the automatic scoring system before we can begin bowling.
- **HOSPITALITY:** will be available for coaches and volunteers.
- **AWARDS:** will be presented shortly after each bowler finishes. Athletes should stay by their lanes until someone comes to award them on the lanes.
- Coaches and parents are **NOT ALLOWED IN COMPETITION AREA**, which includes the walkway behind the lanes. This is per SPECIAL OLYMPICS RULES. Please stay behind this area, and please keep the stairs clear at all times. Parents and coaches are encouraged to be supportive of their athletes, but reminded that "coaching" is prohibited while athletes are competing.
- **ASSISTED RAMP BOWLERS:** Please bring your own ramps. Coaches are not allowed down on the lanes. However, it is appropriate for chaperones and assistants to be on the lanes with these athletes.
- **FOUL LINES WILL BE ON.** If an athlete touches or crosses the line upon delivery of the ball, the ball will be scored as a "zero".
- **ALL BOWLERS (except ramp bowlers) WILL ALTERNATE LANES PER SPECIAL OLYMPICS RULES.**
